RBB partners with KfW to provide grants to energy-intensive companies for the implementation of EE measures

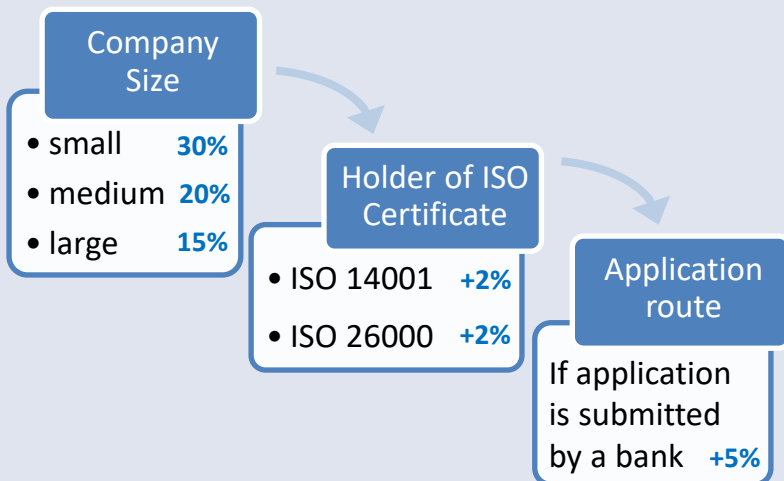
## Why should you invest in EE?

## Programme Background

Given the great potential for EE in the Nepalese industry, Rastriya Banijya Bank Ltd. (RBB) provides grants for the implementation of EE measures in industry, on the basis of a financing agreement with the German Development Bank (KfW).

## Grant rates are calculated depending on several conditions:



The maximum grant size per company is NPR 10 million. In addition, 50-70% of costs for energy audits can be subsidised.

## Eligibility Criteria

### Eligible measures

- are proposed by an Investment Grade Energy Audit (from 2012 or later)
- machinery or equipment has been purchased after 18.05.2017
- do not use second-hand equipment and machinery

### Projects

- must have a minimum investment amount of NPR 1 million
- must cover 30% of the investment costs with a bank loan if they are higher than NPR 5 million
